Made in the USA Sports Festival
Code of Conduct for Volunteers

1. Volunteers shall understand that they are a volunteer for The Made in the USA Sports Festival, and that they are donating their time/service to the Made in the USA Sports Festival. As volunteers, they understand that they will not receive any compensation, benefits or exchange of privileges in return for their service.
2. Volunteers understand that reimbursement for any personal expenses or auto use related to this position shall not be provided unless clearly agreed upon in advance.
3. Volunteers further understand that if they are injured while working as a volunteer it is their full responsibility for any medical bills.
4. In order to protect The Made in the USA Sports Festival volunteers and program participants- at no time may a volunteer be alone with a single child in an area where they cannot be observed by others.
5. Volunteers shall not abuse children including:
 - physical abuse: strike, spank, shake, slap
 - verbal abuse: humiliate, degrade, threaten
 - sexual abuse: inappropriate touch or verbal exchange;Any type of abuse will not be tolerated and will be cause for immediate removal from the program and/or event.
6. Volunteers shall respond to children with respect and consideration and treat all children equally regardless of sex, race, religion, or culture.
7. While performing their duties, volunteers must appear clean, neat, and appropriately attired.
8. Using , possessing, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs during volunteer duties is strictly prohibited.
9. Profanity, inappropriate jokes, sharing intimate details of one's personal life, and any kind of harassment in the presence of program participants is strictly prohibited.
10. Volunteers will portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, courtesy, tact, and maturity.
11. Volunteers may not be alone with children they meet outside of the event. Additionally, volunteers are to have no personal contact with program participants under the age of 18 without the knowledge of the parent(s). This includes any face to face contact as well as electronic contact such as phone calls, text message, e-mails, or any other possible electronic means. Volunteers must not accept any request by a participant under the age of 18, to become a friend as part of their personal web page (Facebook, MySpace, Twitter, etc).
12. Volunteers should promote the core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility in their speech and behavior at the event, with the community, and in any public forum.
